

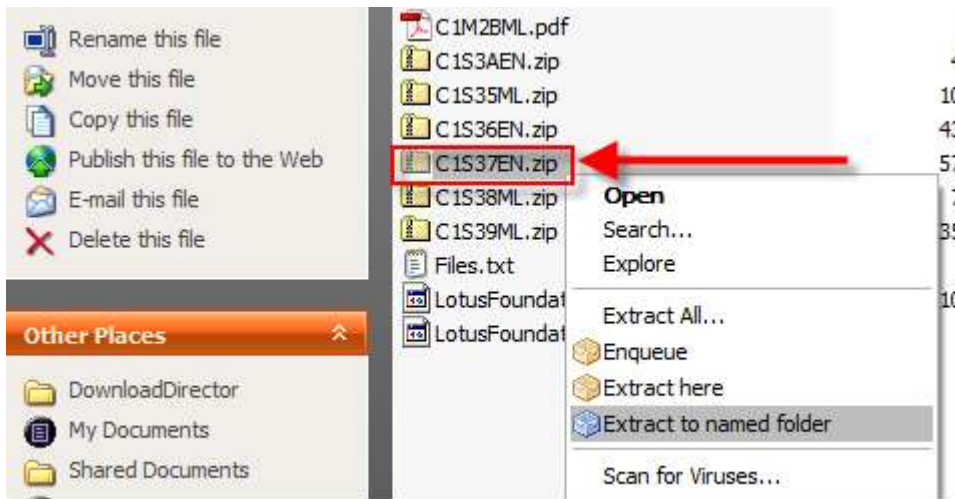
Lotus Domino Installation on Lotus Foundations Server

In this example we will demonstrate the procedure to install Lotus Domino Addon in English in to the Lotus Foundation Server, this Addon is also know as Lotus Foundation Start, Lotus Foundations Start provides email and collaboration using Lotus Domino.

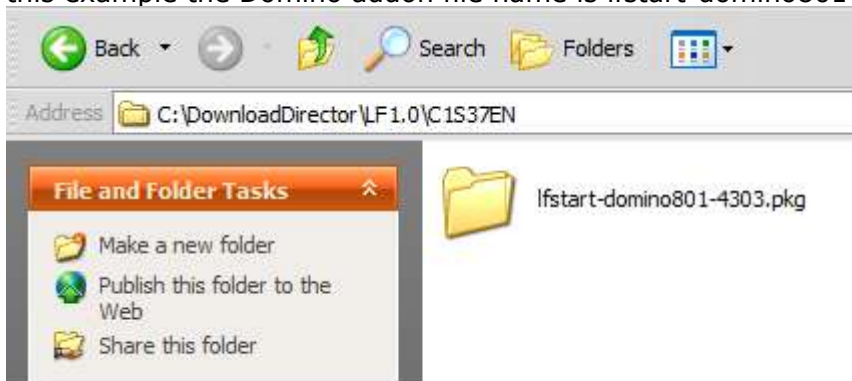
It is important to mention that once you install Lotus Foundation Start (the Domino Addon) you are not going to be able to change the internet domain of your Foundation Server, this is an important note you must be aware.

In this document we will extract the package from the downloaded file from the Passport Advantage Site.

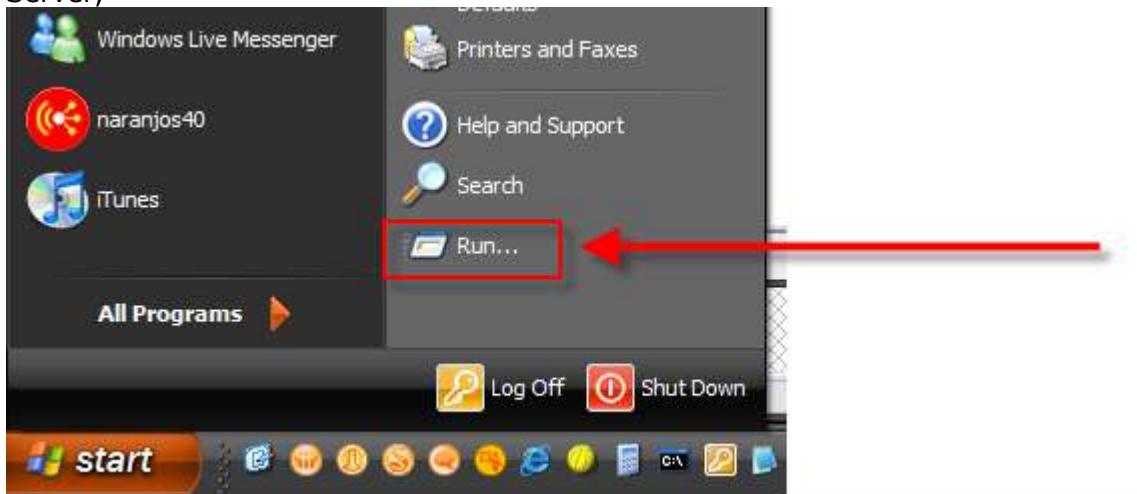
1. Extract the content from the file C1S37EN.ZIP (this is the name of the downloaded file corresponding to IBM Lotus Foundations Start 1.0 - Domino Addon English), use your favorite unzip tool to perform this operation, in this example I´m using ExtractNow (c).



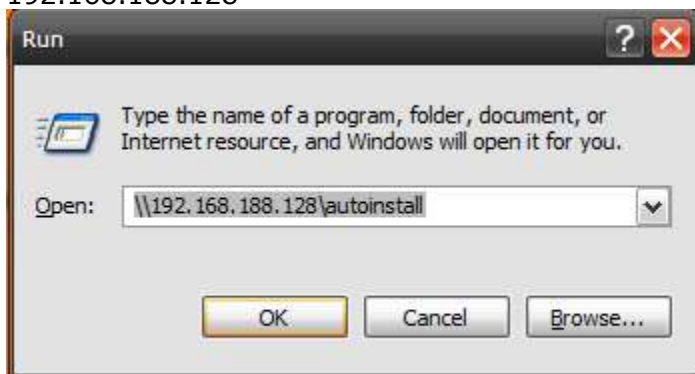
2. Explore the content of the folder where you extracted the ZIP file, you will find a .pkg file, in this example the Domino addon file name is lfstart-domino801-4303.pkg



3. This file must be copied in to special folder located in the Foundation Server, the folder is named `autoinstall`, you will need an administrative user to copy this file in to the file share folder, select Run from the Windows workstation where you have access to the Foundation Server,



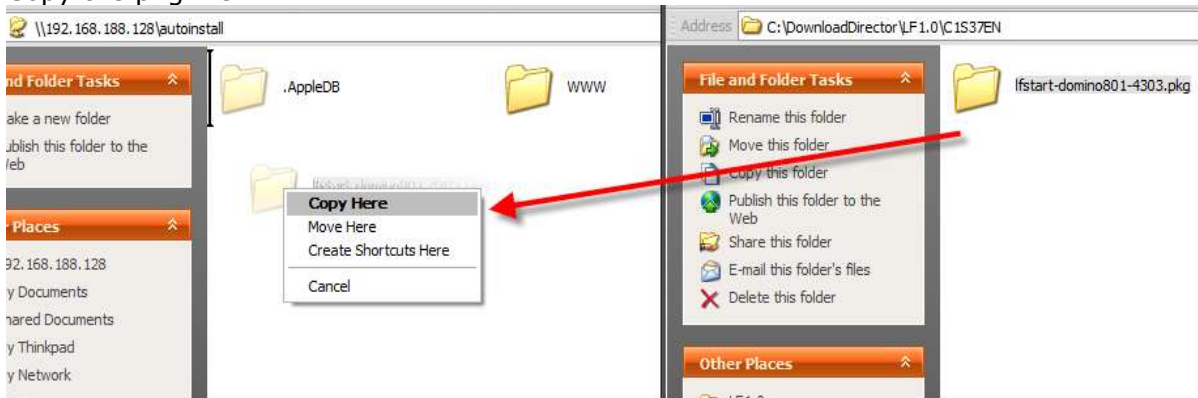
4. Enter the following command `\\IPAddress\autoinstall`, where `IPAddress` is the IP address of your Foundations Server, in our example the IP address of the foundations server is `192.168.188.128`



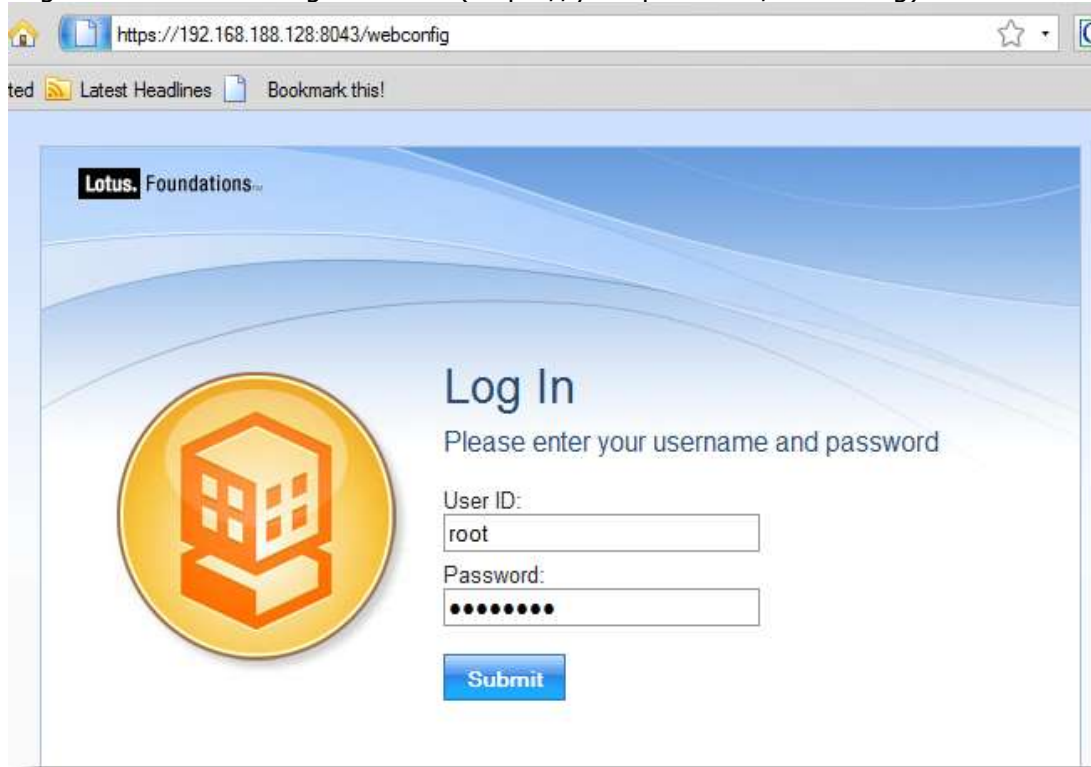
5. Enter your Foundations administrative credential, in our example root is our Lotus Foundation Administrator.



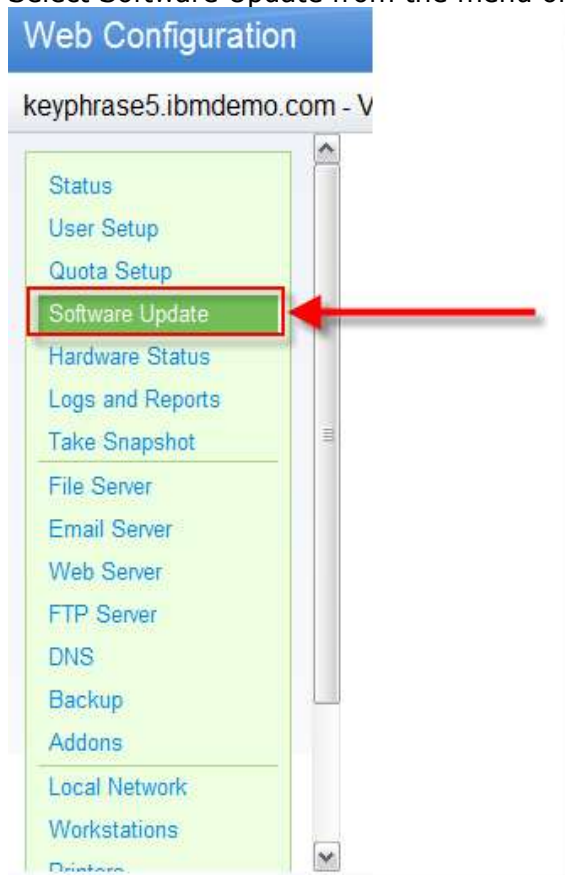
6. Copy the pkg file



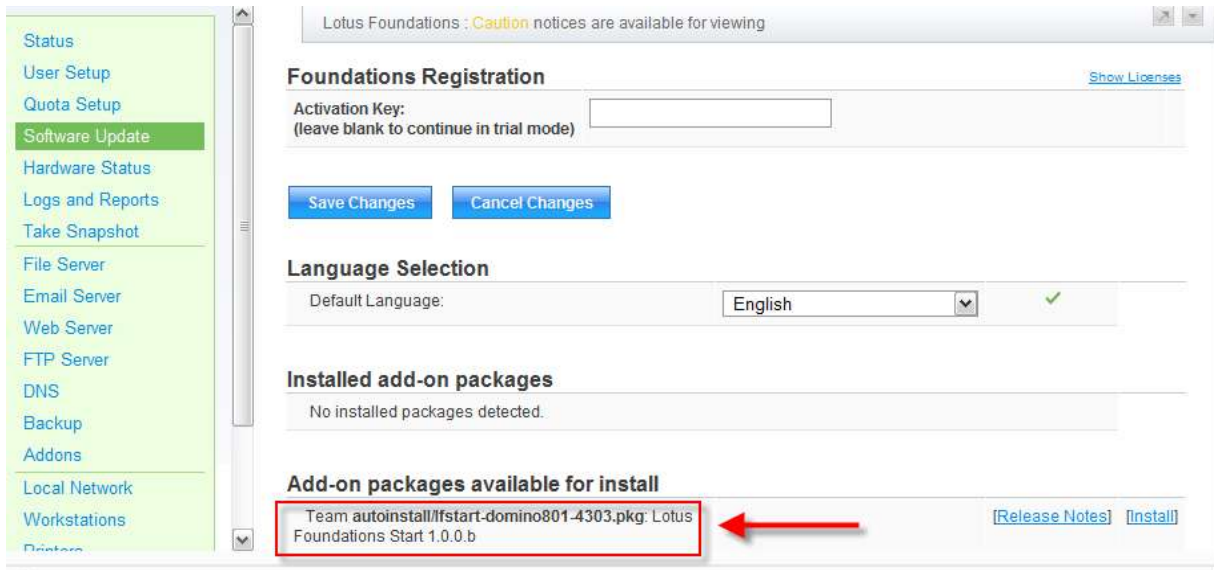
7. Log in to the webconfig interface (https://youripaddress/webconfig)



8. Select Software Update from the menu on the left side of the Webconfig screen

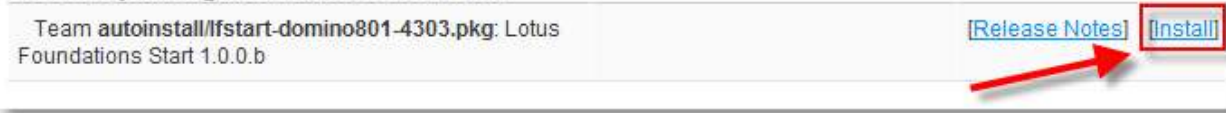


9. You will see a list of installable package, once of this package is your recently Domino addon (Lotus Foundation Start), you should read something like Team autoinstall/lfstart-domino801-4303.pkg.

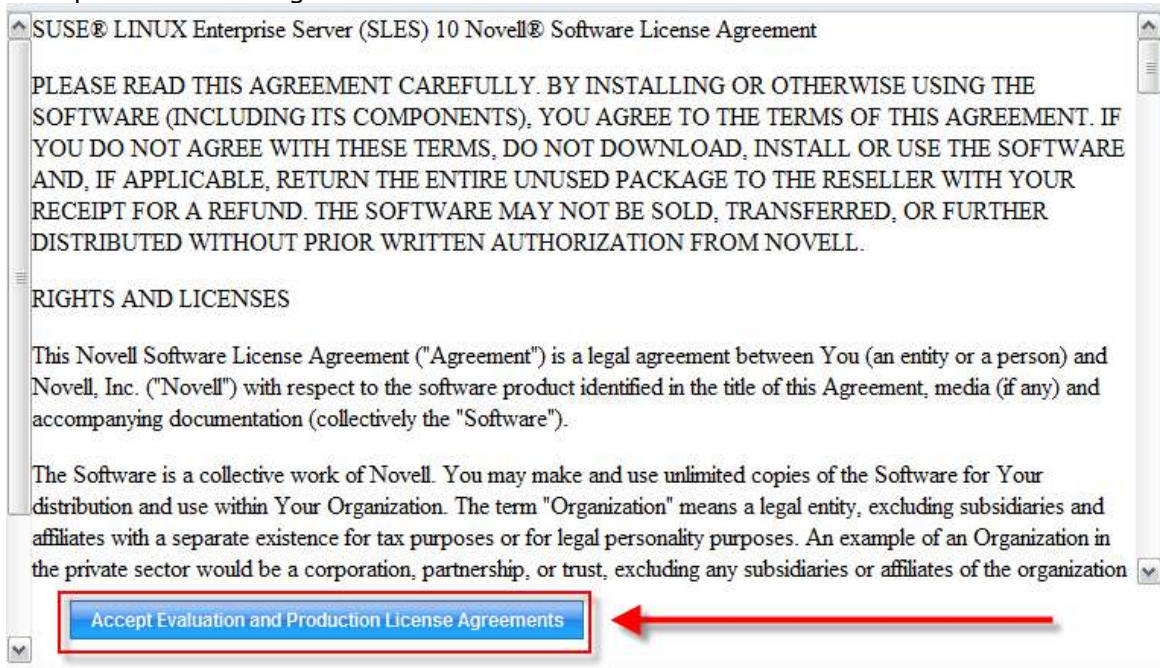


10. Click the install link

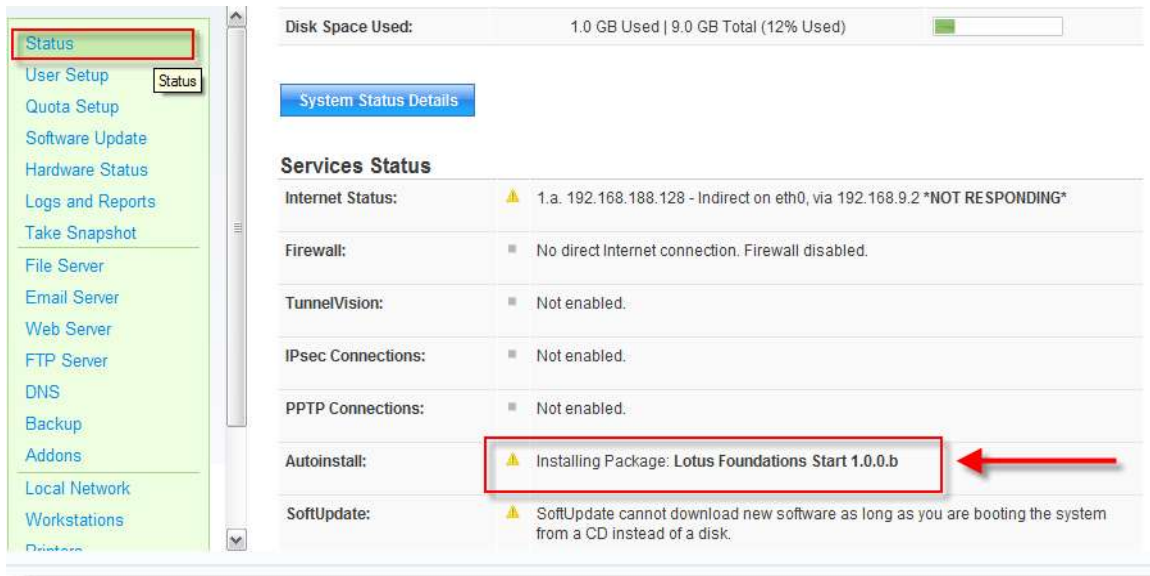
Add-on packages available for install



11. Accept the License Agreement in the next 3 screens



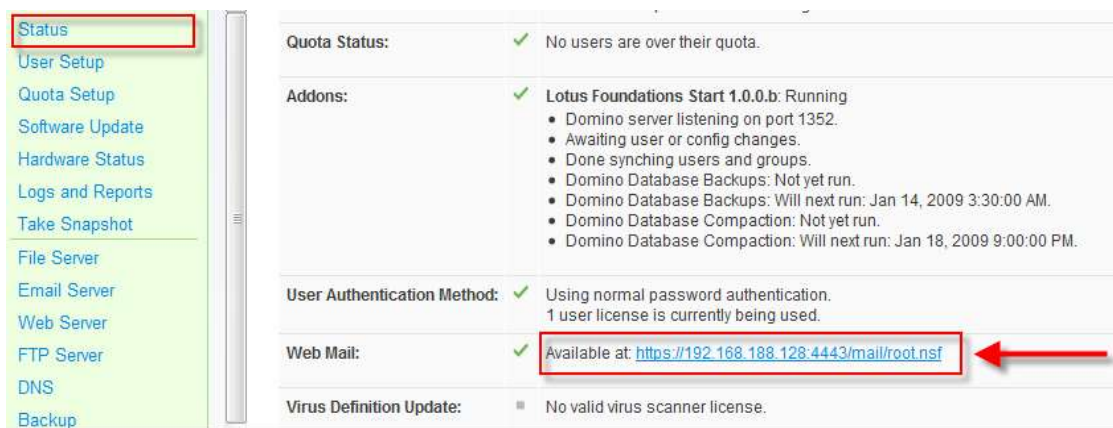
12. In the Status page, you will find the status of the Package, while the package is installed you will notice a yellow triangle and the text: Installing Package Lotus Foundations Star 1.0.0.b



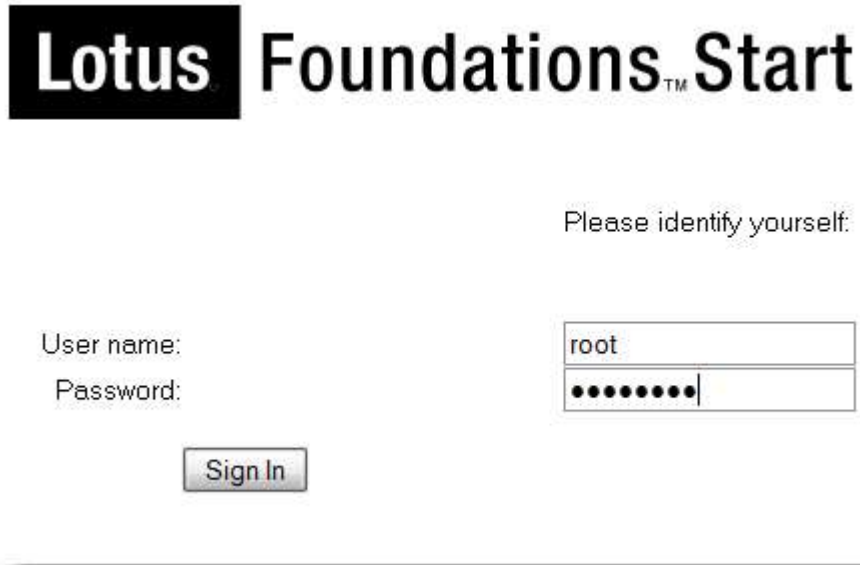
13. After few more minutes you will see a green light, some messages



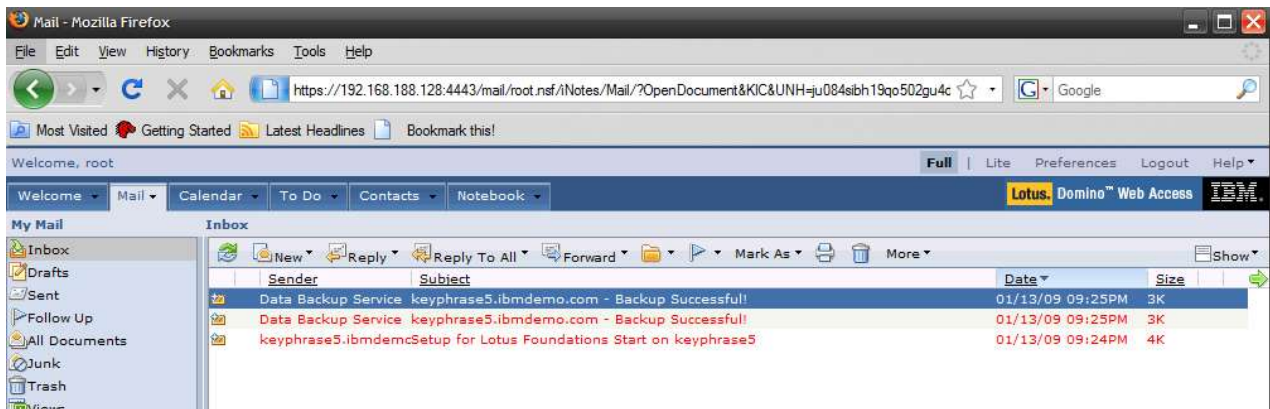
14. After few minutes, Domino Web Access is ready to be used, in the Status menu you will find a direct access to the root web mail, (probably you will need accept the SSL certificate)



15. Enter your root credentials

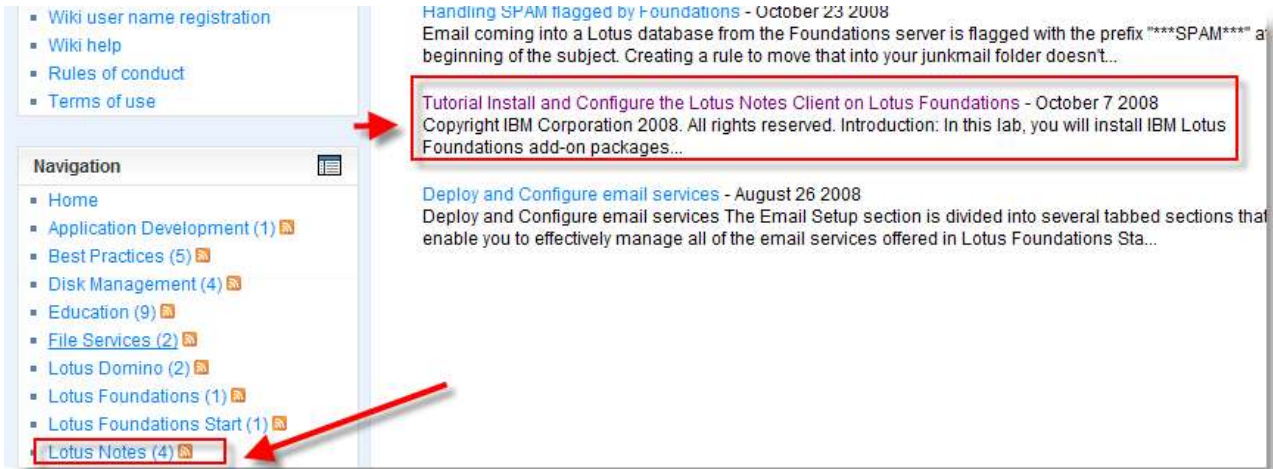


16. Now you will be able to access your Web Access Mail
